(c) Proposal – to amend the Sail Identification rule to permit the application of sail letters/ numbers as "white graphics on a black background." APPROVED – 14 YES; 2 NO.

7) Championship Rules

(a) To discus the development of Championship (event) Rules for Foil racing; and authorise the Committee to publish for 2020.

APPROVED - 14 YES; 2 Abstention.
